Outpatient Services has been on the "Move"

As you may have noticed starting at the beginning in June, patients who need *outpatient services* are now entering our hospital through our Main Entrance on Carthage Street rather than through our Emergency Entrance. By separating the entrances, we are able to focus on the immediate needs of our emergency patients as well as the specific needs of our same-day surgery patients.

This change brings several benefits to our outpatients. First, it allows easier access to parking and a shorter walk into the hospital. We have expanded our parking for patients at the Carthage Street parking lot and to the left of the hospital by the cafeteria. Outpatients will immediately see the Greeter's Desk, where they will check in. Once registered, they'll be taken to the procedure area.

Family members who are waiting for same-day surgery patients now have two designated waiting areas. One waiting area is in the Main Lobby close to the cafeteria.

For those looking for more comfort or a place to read or watch TV, a second area is a brief walk to the left of the elevators.

This glass-enclosed space offers more privacy to discuss the procedures and outcomes with the physician.

Outpatient Services include:

Vascular, GI Lab, Lab, Diagnostic Imaging (will go directly to the Radiology department), Direct Admits and Observations, Cardio-

pulmonary, and Cardiac Caths.

Patients continuing to use the ER Entrance include:

Maternity patients, Patients having sleep studies, and Lithotripsy patients.
